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This is the spatial part of SLN-V.


The spatial part consists of thirty spatial items not ordered by difficulty and structured as 3x3 matrices. Each item is made of three series of three 3x3 matrices for a total of nine matrices per item. To answer each item one has to complete the matrix/matrices right below which a question mark is placed; furthermore the matrix/matrices to be completed have unfinished columns and rows done specifically, so that an answer will be considered valid if and only if the columns and rows are united and made continuous. In the absence of such a formality, the answer will be considered invalid or as not replied to. Therefore, also in the case in which one doesn't know how to answer to an item, one has to leave the matrix/matrices as they are. Furthermore it is specified that for each matrix to complete in an item, is it one or more matrices, only one answer and one answer alone is accepted, but one can, in broad terms, accompany each answer with an explanation which is not necessary, but for sure appreciated, whichever the reason might be (meaning that you can add an explanation because you are either uncertain of your answer, because you want to add to one or more answers an explanation or


because you want to add an explanation for whichever other reason). While a special case is if you are building a personal answer sheet which you'll send to me. If you reply to the items which contain more matrices to complete, you'll have to write the answers in the order in which the matrices to complete appear (namely extrapolating an order by reading each row of the series from left to right and classifying the order of the rows of the series counting from top to bottom) or, at least, it must be clear to which matrix the answer is referred. To do so I do not impose any rules, thus you can do as you wish provided that the answers given are crystal clear. Whereas, if an item is left unanswered, write the item's number and point out that you are not answering to said item. This as well can be done as you prefer as long as it is crystal clear. Lastly, the score attributed to each spatial item, regardless of the amount of matrices to complete, is of one if everything is correct, or of zero if the answer given is incorrect or if there are more answers to give and at least one of them is wrong or if you don't reply to the item. Right below these instructions you can find a visual example that shows how to answer to the items.
